

Stage 1 – Age 7–9

Curious & Conscious

She's growing taller, stronger, and more curious. Though there's no visible development yet, she might notice older girls wearing bras and start asking, "When will I wear one?" This stage is all about emotional readiness — more about confidence than physical need.
