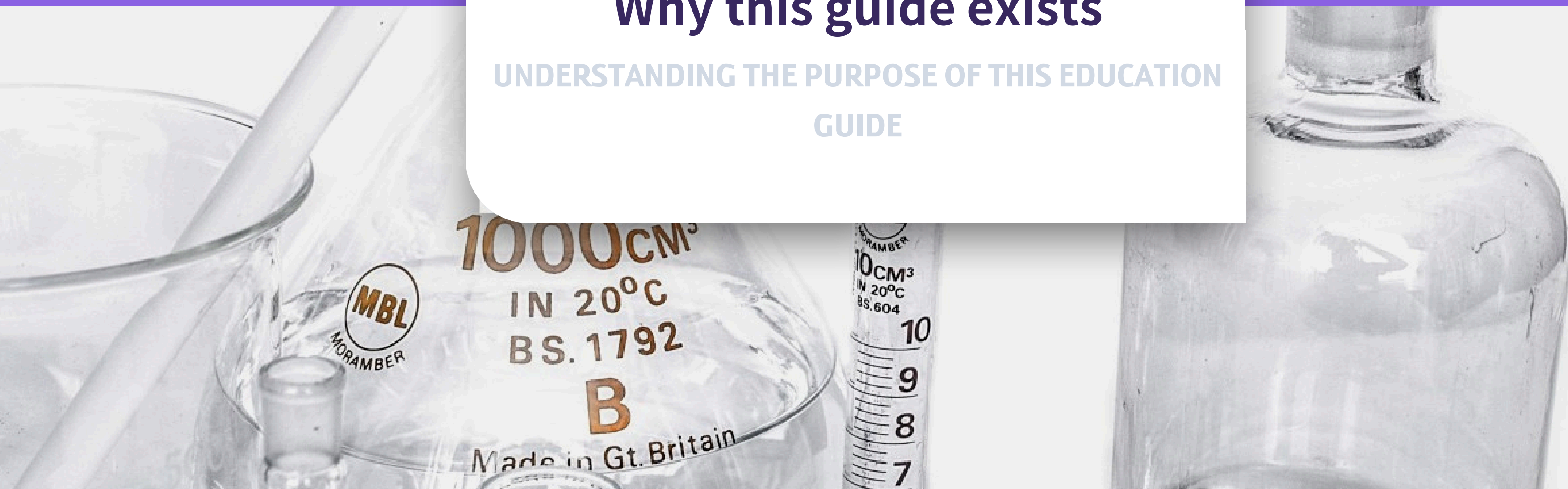

Stage-Based Development System



Stage 1

- early awareness
- mild sensitivity
- minimal support

Stage 2-3

- visible development
- increased sensitivity
- need for gentle structure

What is actually happening?



Posture changes during puberty are often not structural issues.

They are usually related to:

- body awareness
- comfort in clothing
- emotional sensitivity

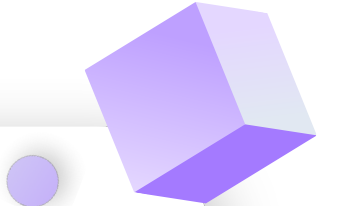

Why posture changes appear



- increased body awareness
- desire to reduce visibility
- unconscious posture adjustment
- clothing discomfort

WHAT KIND OF SUPPORT GROWING BODIES NEED





Comfort needs



- soft breathable materials
- gentle coverage
- non-restrictive fit
- light shaping (not compression)

Stage-based comfort principle

HOW NEEDS EVOLVE ACROSS STAGES





Stage principle



Comfort evolves with development, not age

- Stage 1 → softness & protection
- Stage 2-3 → gentle structure
- Adult → full comfort support

COMMON BEHAVIORAL AND PHYSICAL SIGNS





What parents may notice

- slouching posture
- avoiding fitted clothing
- frequent adjustments
- discomfort in certain fabrics

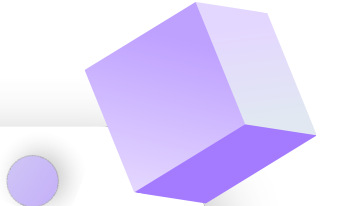
